COMMENCEMENT OF DEREGISTRATION NOTIFICATION TO COMPANIES AND CLOSE CORPORATIONS

The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission ("CIPC") has commenced with the notification in terms of Companies Regulation 40, 2011 for companies and close corporations referred for deregistration due to non-compliance with Annual Returns.

It should be noted that the deregistration status for companies and close corporations in deregistration due to non-compliance with Annual Returns will only be cancelled/uplifted upon the filing of ALL outstanding Annual Returns as well as the required Audited Financial Statements (AFS) or Financial Accountability Supplements (FAS).

Lastly, continued non-compliance will result in final deregistration of the company or close corporation.
