





- Entities pay SDL (1% of payroll) to SARS
- SARS distributes 80% to SETAs
- SARS distributes 20% to NSF
- SETAs use funds for:
 - Administrative costs
 - Grants (to be claimed back by entities)



- 3.2 Types of grants: Mandatory grant
- 3.3 Types of grants: Discretionary grant
- > 2 types of grants:

Mandatory grant

- SETAs will pay mandatory grants to all employers who meet the prescribed criteria. This includes submitting a report once a year (called a workplace skills plan and annual training report).
- Limited to a maximum of 20% of the total SDL paid by the entity.

Discretionary grant

• Discretionary grants are paid at the sole discretion of the SETA (not guaranteed).

Example for mandatory grant:

R500,000 (salary per year) x 1% (SDL) = R5,000 R5,000 x 20% = R1,000 (maximum amount)








Your SDL payments are up to date with SARS (Remember: 1% of your salary bill should be paid over to SARS)

IMPORTANT: You will not include an employee only once. You must ensure you include the employee for all the training that is planned for him / her for the coming year.



Discretionary Grants


The Fasset Board determines the areas of strategic importance for the sector by assessing the information from Mandatory Grant applications, the Sector Skills Plan (SSP) and other research conducted from time to time. In addition to this background research and information, the National Skills Development Strategy (NSDS), coordinated by DHET, guides the development of strategic areas within Fasset's sector.
