The Minister of Justice and Correctional Services has passed regulations in terms of the <u>Promotion of Access to Information Act, No. 2 of 2000</u> (PAIA). The regulations were published in the Government Gazette No. 45057 of 27 August 2021.

Section 10 of PAIA obliges the Information Officer to update and make available the existing guide that has been compiled by the <u>South African Human Rights</u> <u>Commission</u> ("guide"). The guide sets out the way in which a person can exercise the rights conferred in terms of PAIA. Regulation 3 of the new regulations now requires an Information Officer to have a copy of the guide available for public inspection in at least two of the official languages at his/her registered head office.

An Information Officer must on written request, in the prescribed format, provide copies of the guide in the official language of the person requesting the copies.

An Information Officer may not charge a fee for a copy of the guide or for the inspection of a copy of the guide.


